

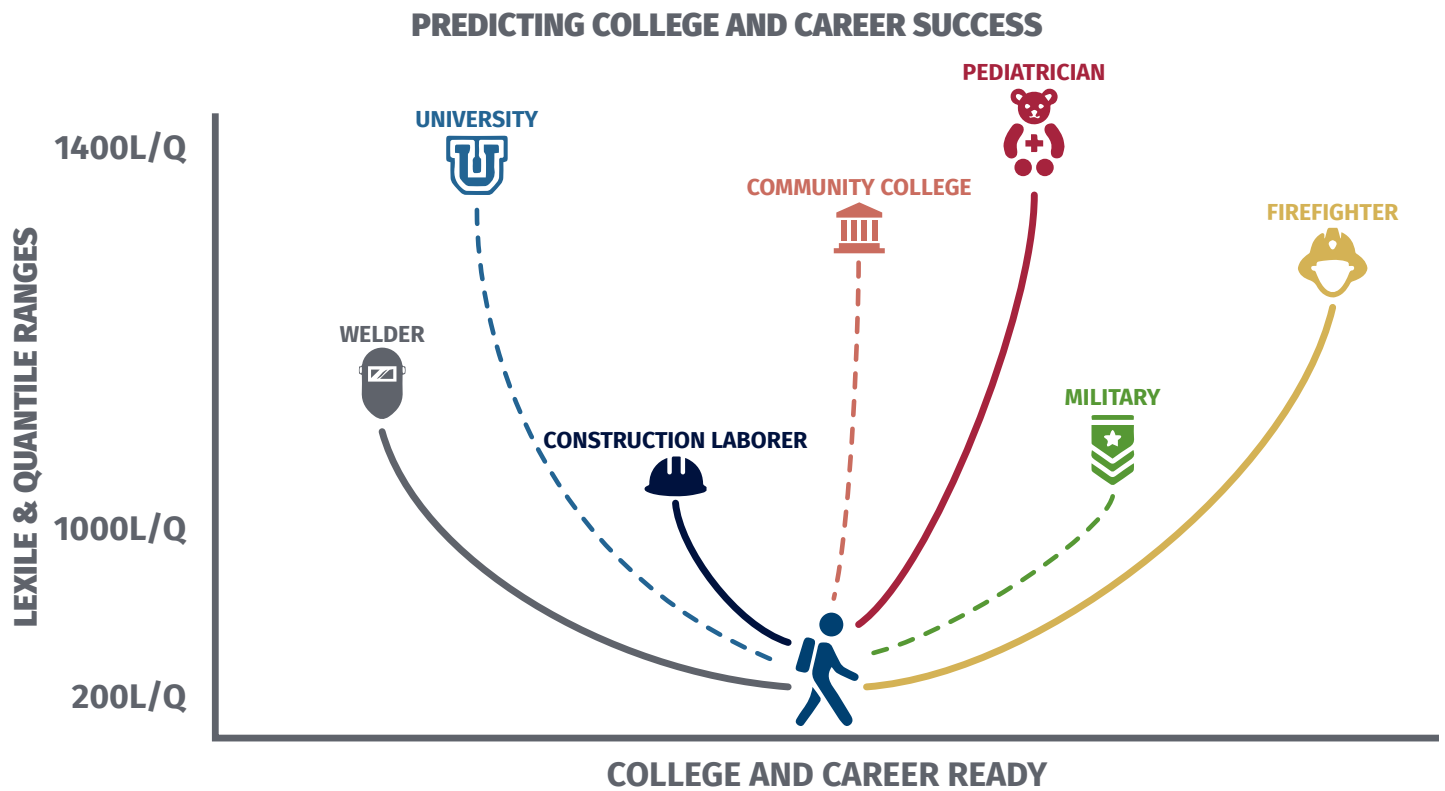


DID YOU KNOW?

80% of the jobs of the future in West Virginia will require additional education beyond a high school diploma.

The median pay for students with more than a high school diploma increases significantly and the likelihood of unemployment decreases.

The West Virginia School Accountability System uses Lexile and Quantile scores to determine a student’s reading and math ability and predict future success in various career fields.

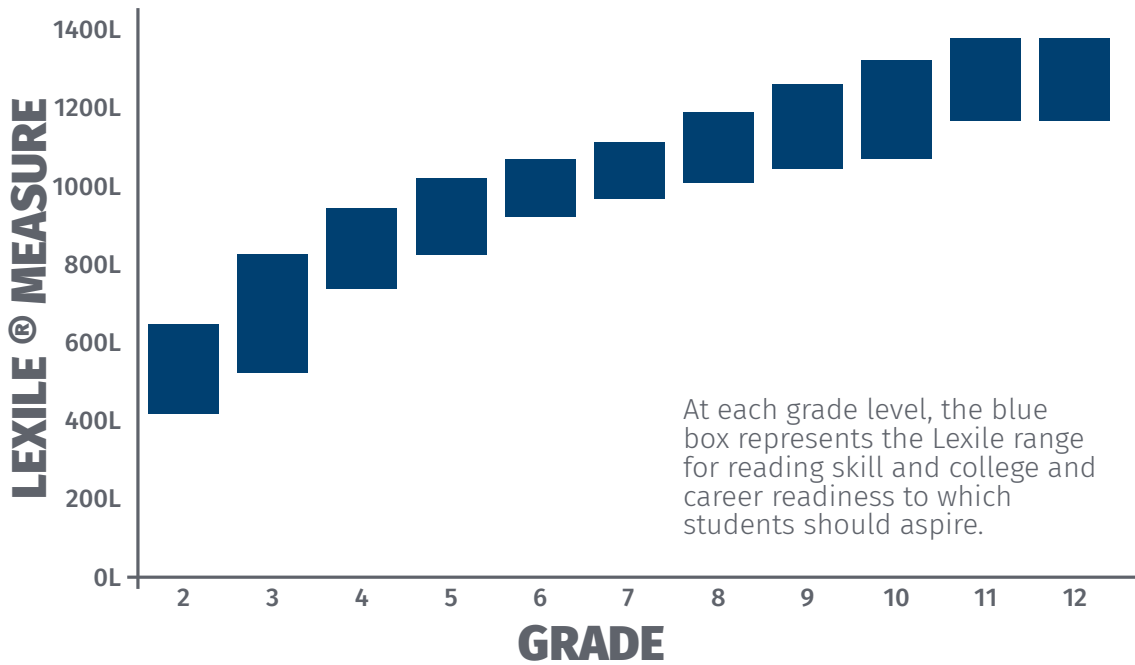


DEFINITIONS

Lexile: Range of numbers which correspond to a grade level determining the student’s ability to read and understand text.

Quantile: Range of numbers which correspond to a grade level indicating the student’s ability to solve math problems.
