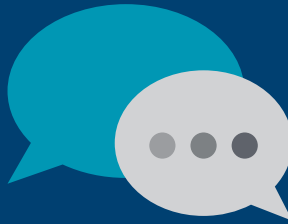


Celebrate West Virginia's Diversity
