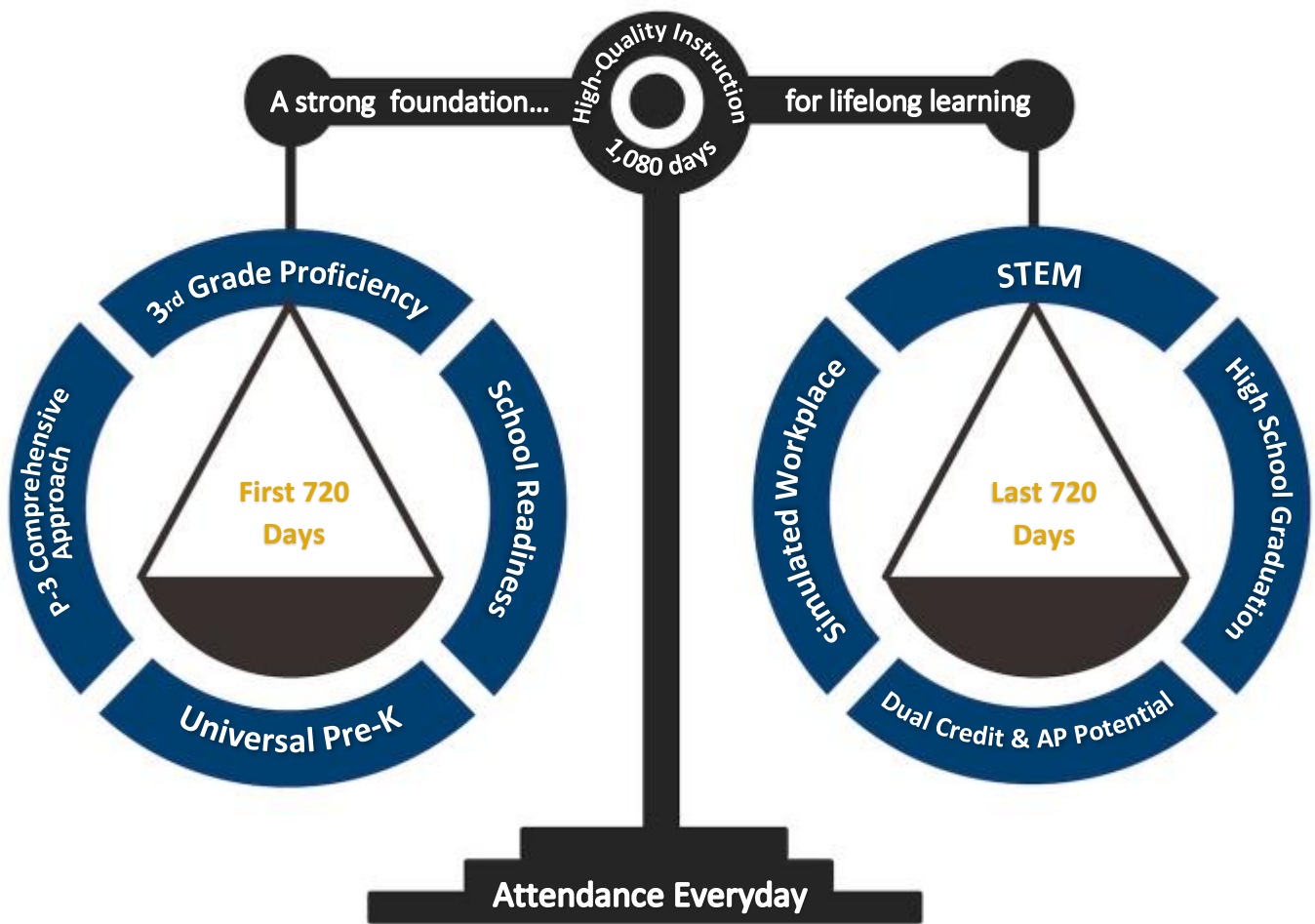


College and Career Readiness in West Virginia
