

Student Level Information Accessed by WVDE

Following is a list of student-level data elements that may be accessed by staff at the West Virginia Department of Education to meet statutory requirements and fulfill job-related responsibilities, including administering educational programs and providing technical assistance and support to schools and districts.

Element	Reason for Collection
Name	Identification for school- and district-level reports, participation in assessments, the production of parent reports for assessments, and verification of information by school personnel
Physical Address	Determination of enrollment catchment zones
Mailing Address	Reports to parents, special education mailings
Sex	Reporting
Birthdate	Determination of funding and service eligibility, when based on age
Country of Birth	Determination of immigrant status, reporting, funding determinations for districts with significant immigrant populations
Grade Level	Verification of information by school personnel, correct identification for courses, assessments, and reporting
WVEIS ID Number	Unique ID used only within the state student data system
Social Security Number (SSN)* *Per state law (W. Va. Code §18-2-5f) and WVBE Policy 4350, schools are required to ask parents to provide a student's SSN when a student is enrolled in a public school. There is no mandate, however, that parents comply with the request, and there is no consequence for parent or child if a parent chooses not to provide that piece of information. This list includes the student-level information that WVDE accesses through our required and certified data collections, including assessments. The data included here represents the information WVDE requires for reporting and state-level administration; reasons for collecting each piece of information are also included. WVDE maintains only information required for mandatory reporting and administration of educational programs and student supports. All public reports are produced in the aggregate with appropriate suppression rules applied for small groups of students.
